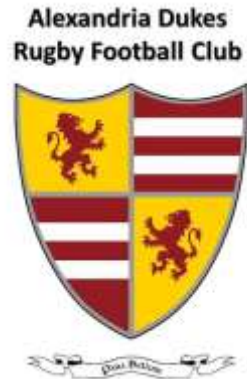

The Alexandria Dukes is a social rugby club established in 2011 that aims to build a friendly and inclusive club culture where amateur rugby can be enjoyed by all. We believe rugby should be enjoyed off the field as much as on, and pride ourselves on a strong social culture, always participating in the vital post-match festivities.

The Club currently competes in the one-team competition of the NSW Suburban Rugby Union. We are aiming to re-establish a 2nd Grade, for which an Assistant Coach will be sought (in consultation with the Head Coach).

Overview of the Role:

Time Commitment:

4-6 hours per week. Training is traditionally held on a Wednesday night near Redfern/Alexandria (2017 location TBC) and games are played late Saturday afternoons.

The Club's home ground is Booralee Park, Botany. Away games are held at various locations across Sydney.

Remuneration:

Recognising the amateur status of the Club and Subbies, this is an unpaid, volunteer role. However, recognising the value of coaching development, the Club will cover the costs for the successful applicant to complete applicable ARU Coaching courses.
